Grant to the Reverend David Evans and others, 2 Acres of land of Richmond - District of Dalhousie. In Trust for a Burialling Ground in connection with the Presbyterian Church

Victoria by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen Defender of the Faith &c &c &c

To all to whom these Presents shall come - Greeting.

Recorded 11th March 1845

Know Ye, that We, of Our special Grace, certain knowledge and mere motion have given and granted and by these presents Do give and grant unto The Reverend David Evans of the Town of Richmond in the County of Carleton in the District of Dalhousie, Clerk; Anthony Philip of the same place Esquire, and William Gordon, the Elder, of the Township of Goulburn in the County and District aforesaid, Yeoman, their Heirs and assigns forever All that Parcel or tract of land situate in the Town of Richmond in the County of Carleton in the District of Dalhousie of Our said Province, containing by admeasurement two Acres, be the same, more or less, Being composed of Lot number Eleven on the East side of Fortune Street, and Lot number Eleven on the West side of Maillard Street in the said Town of Richmond - Together with all the wood and Waters thereon lying and being under the reservations, limitations and conditions hereinafter expressed, having nevertheless to Us, Our Heirs and Successors all Mines of Gold and Silver, that shall or may be hereafter found on any part of the said Parcel or Tract of land hereby given and granted as aforesaid; and saving and reserving to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Wild Pine Trees that shall or may now or hereafter grow or be growing on any part of the said Parcel or tract of land hereby granted as aforesaid To have and to hold the said Parcel or tract of land hereby given and granted to them the said Reverend David Evans, Anthony Philip and William Gordon the Elder, their Heirs and assigns forever In Trust for the benefit of the Presbyterian Church in connection with the Synod of Canada, for a Burialling Ground in the said Town of Richmond Provided always nevertheless that in case any of them the said David Evans Anthony Philip and William Gordon or any succeeding Trustee or Trustees to be appointed as hereinafter mentioned shall happen to die or be desirous of being discharged from the Trusts or Powers hereby in them reposed or vested or become incapable of acting in the same, then and in every such case and so often as the same shall happen full power and authority is given by these Presents to them the said David Evans, Anthony Philip and William Gordon, the Survivor or Survivors of them or any of them, or the Heir of such Survivor, or any succeeding Trustee or Trustees of them the said David Evans, Anthony Philip, William Gordon or any of them, or the Survivor or Survivors of them or any of them, or the Heir of such survivor by any writing or writings under their or his hands and Seals, hand and Seal, to be by them or him sealed and delivered in the presence of and attested by two or more credible witnesses, to nominate substitute and appoint any other fit person in the room and place of any of them the said David Evans, Anthony Philip, William
